Summer 2021	<p>Credit recovery options will be made available to our 9 – 12 students.</p> <p>Breakfast/lunch will be provided and transportation as needed at summer school to ensure at-risk students participation in summer programming.</p>
2021 - 2023	<p>Data collected during the 2020-2021 and 2021-2022 school year will be reviewed during collaboration time to determine the gaps and instructional adjustments needed.</p> <p>Credit Recovery options will continue to be made available.</p>
